THE SEASON OF LENT begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6th. Masses times are 6:40 am, 8:00 am, 5:00 pm & 6:30 pm. Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation, but you are encouraged to attend Mass.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. Fasting means eating only one full meal with two small meals (ages 18-59). Abstinence means eating no meat, and no soup or gravy made from meat (over age 14). All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Sickness, hard manual labor, pregnancy, etc., excuse a person from these obligations.

- † **Stations of the Cross** are on Fridays at 6:00 pm (beginning March 8th) and on Wednesdays at 2:45 pm (beginning March 13th) with the school children. The Stations allow us to reflect upon Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection.
- † Try a Holy Hour for Lent! For those of you contemplating Adoration but are uncertain of the commitment, sign up during Lent. Please check the Adoration chart in the Narthex or call the Parish Office for more information.
