A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

This weekend is the Epiphany. We celebrate the moments in which it was revealed to humanity that God became human. This includes the three wise men visiting the manger (hence our statue change in our manger scene) and the Baptism of our Lord by St. John the Baptist.



Many families will celebrate Epiphany with an opportunity to bless their homes. You can simply look up the house blessing. The end result is above the door to your house you place the first two numbers of the year, adding the letters CMB (to honor the three Wise Men: Casper, Melchior, and Balthazar). Then you add the last two numbers of the year and displaying this sign over the top of the door of their home. The letters also stand for the Latin phrase, "Christus mansionem benedicat," or, "Christ, bless this house."

The numbers represent the year (2023).
The letters represent both the names of the Magi (Caspar, Melchoir, and Balthasar) and the phrase
"Christus Mansionem Benedicat,"
which is Latin for
"May Christ Bless the House."


