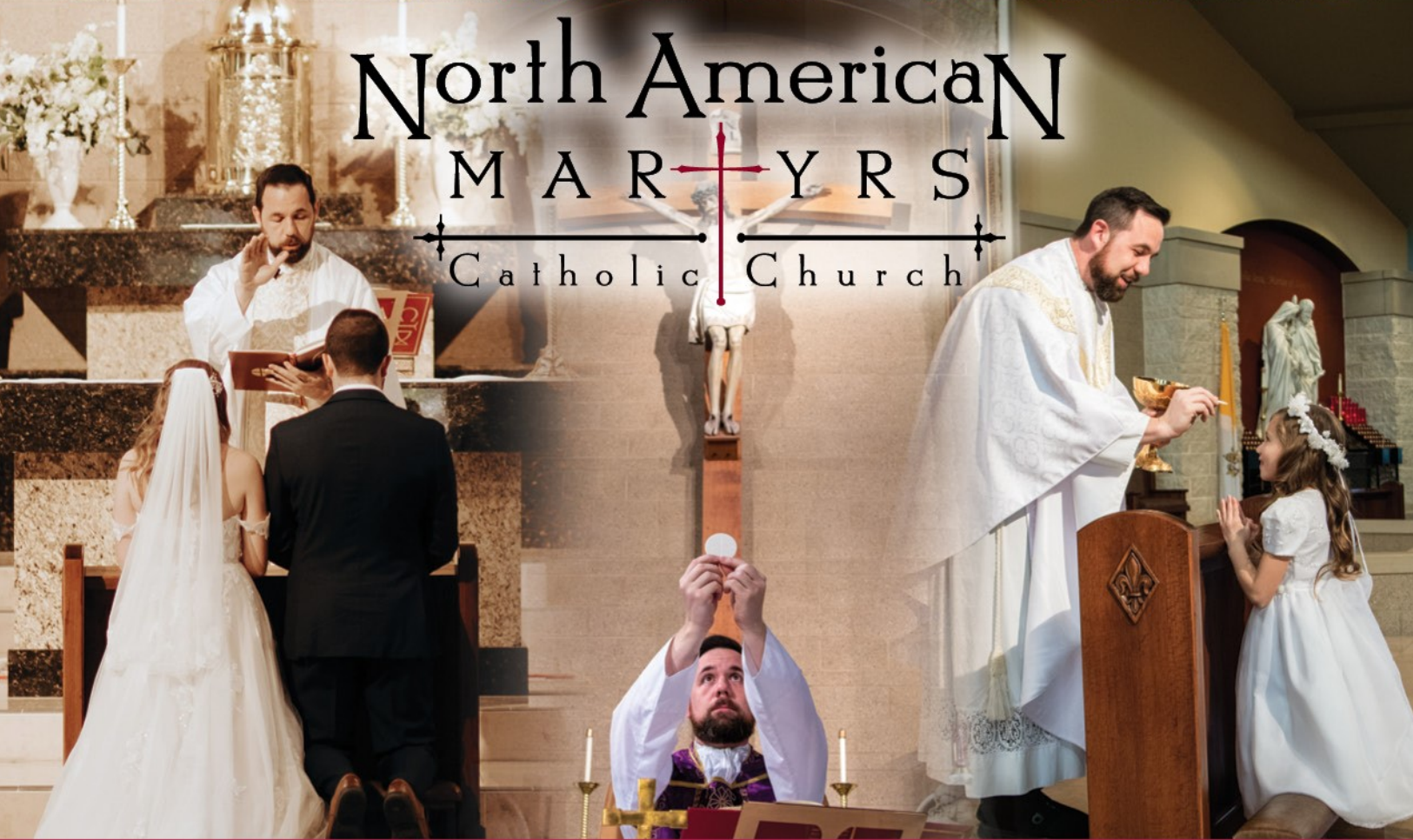

CHRISTMAS MASS OBLIGATIONS

With Christmas falling on a Monday this year, this means that there are two Mass obligations, the Sunday obligation and the Christmas obligation. A person cannot fulfill both obligations with one Mass.

In order to fulfill a Mass obligation, we must attend either on the day of the feast or on the evening preceding (*Code of Canon Law* 1248). Therefore, a Sunday morning Mass could not possibly qualify as satisfying the Mass obligation the following day, since it is in the morning.

In order to satisfy the Sunday obligation, a Catholic could attend the Saturday evening Mass or Mass at some time on Sunday. In order to satisfy the Christmas obligation, a Catholic could attend Mass on a Sunday at 4 p.m. or later or on Christmas Day itself on Monday. No matter how we slice it, two obligations equals two Masses.

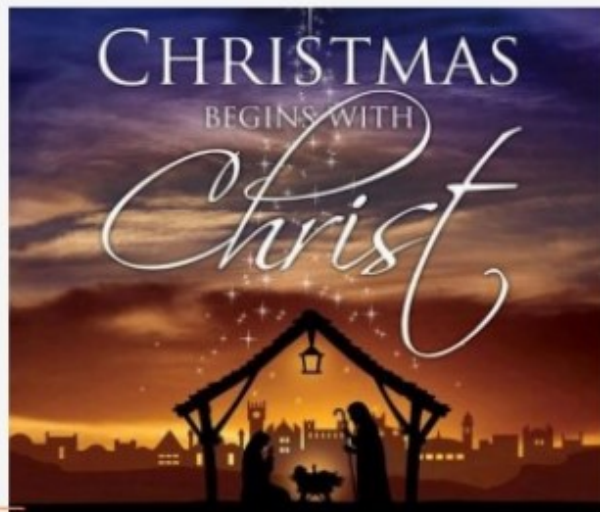
