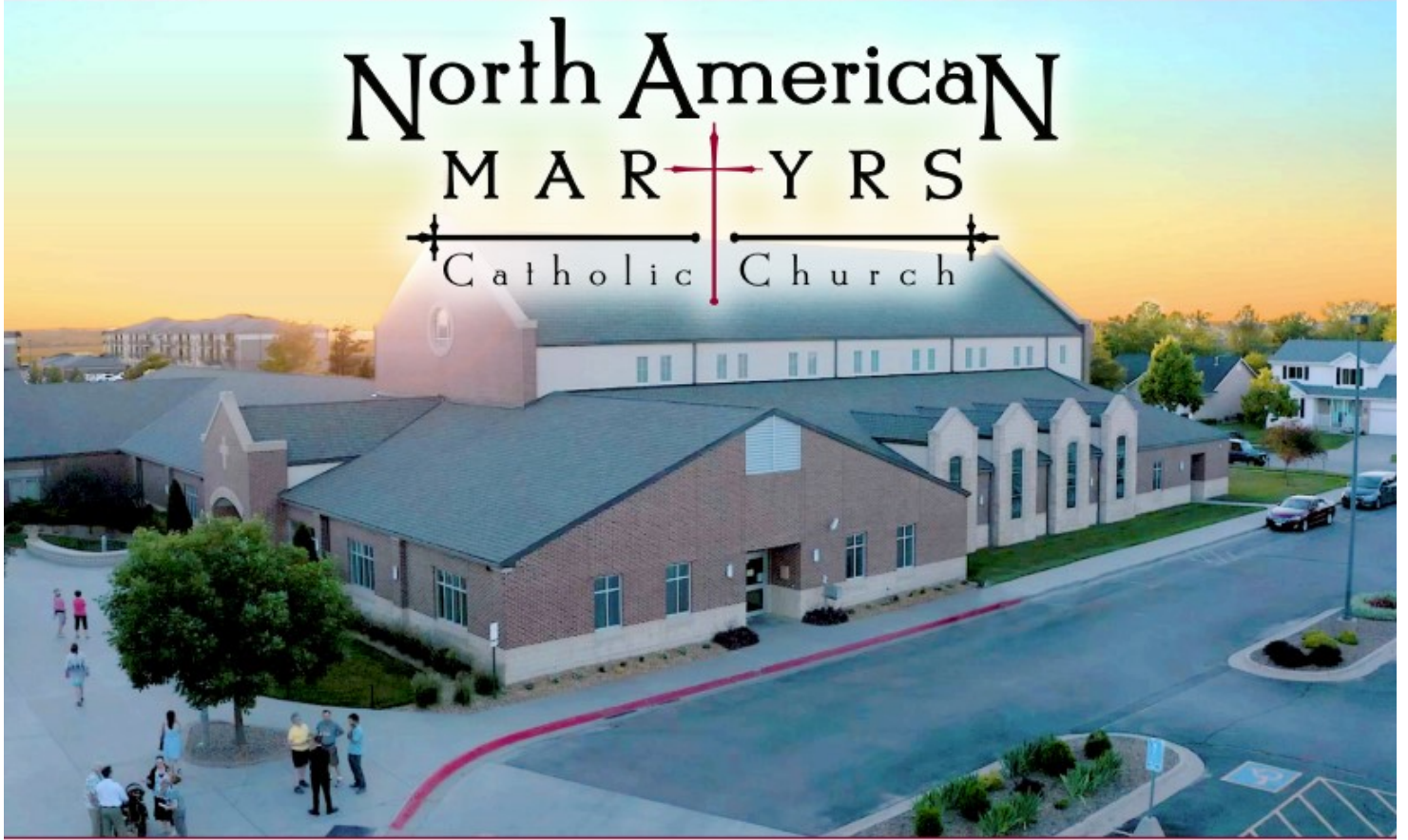

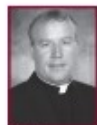

A Note from our Assistant Pastor...

Dear NAM Family,

In our Second Reading for this Sunday, Paul provided us with a powerful message of faith, hope, and eternal glory when he said, "It is written: 'I believed, therefore I spoke.' We too believe, and therefore we speak." This is a great reminder that our faith is supposed to drive us into action, and one way we can use that voice of faith is by participating in the Charity and Stewardship Appeal.



Since its establishment in 1971 by Bishop Flavin, this appeal has been instrumental in supporting the needs of our diocese. It has funded our Catholic Education Programs, Catholic Social Services, the Newman Center, the Retreat House, Pro-Life Activities, and the Youth Ministry Office. Through our contributions and sacrifices, although they may seem small, are building something eternal. Paul even told the Corinthians, "For this momentary light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to what is seen but to what is unseen; for what is seen is transitory, but what is unseen is eternal."

By participating in this appeal, we are not just giving money – we are investing in the future of our Church. We are ensuring that Catholic Social Services can continue to assist the needy, that the Newman Center can provide spiritual guidance to young adults, and that the Pro-Life initiatives can continue to uphold the sanctity of life. 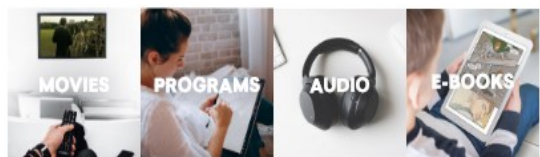

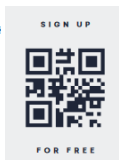

ARTICLE I, SECTION 31

Fetal viability means the point in pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the patient's treating health care practitioner, there is a significant likelihood of the fetus' sustained survival outside the uterus without the application of extraordinary medical measures."
