

FORMED THE CATHOLIC FA

CHANGE IN THE EUCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE ROUTE

Due to unforeseen construction on Locust Street in Grand Island, the path for the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, from St. Mary's Cathedral to St. Anne's in Doniphan on June 19th, has changed **significantly** from what has been advertised.

Instead of the prior plan, the Diocese of Grand Island will be conducting a Eucharistic Procession around Grand Island from St. Mary's Cathedral and back following their Mass. At 11:30, Bishop Hanefeldt will meet Bishop Conley at the 9-mile bridge, and hand off the Blessed Sacrament.

Because there is <u>very little</u> parking at the bridge, and almost no shoulder to walk on, for safety reasons the decision was made that only Bishop Conley and the Perpetual Pilgrims will make the 2.5 mile walk from the bridge to Doniphan. Any lay faithful who would like to join in the procession may join in at the entrance to Doniphan, at roughly 1st and Bartelt Avenue.


The procession will likely arrive at Doniphan at or around 12:30 p.m. and make its way through town until it reaches St. Anne's Catholic Church. Then there will be Eucharistic Adoration until a 4:30 p.m. reception for the pilgrims and attendees.




