

A NOTE FROM SEMINARIAN TYLER JOHNSON...

Earlier this week, we heard Jesus speaking to his disciples in the Gospel that "the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest" (Mt. 9:37-38). Sometimes, people ask why, if



there are so few priests, does it take so long to become one? As Rome was not built in a day, neither does a holy priest sprout up in a day. The Church has thought about this question and has recently updated seminary formation. A new "propaedeutic year" has been established for seminarians entering their first year, intended to give young men a solid foundation of prayer and virtue by giving them a healthy separation from the world allowing them to more effectively hear God's voice and respond freely to His call in their lives. Additionally, my class in seminary will be entering the new "synthesis stage" at the end of seminary, likely involving six months in a parish as a deacon with opportunity for pastoral experience before priestly ordination.

As for me, I am currently entering my second year of Theology studies at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD. I grew up in Lincoln at St. John the Apostle Parish. I went to Pius X High School and attended UNL for a year before entering seminary in the fall of 2019. After having finished my fifth year of seminary, I am about two and a half years from being ordained a deacon in December of 2026 if it is God's will.

As it stands, I have only two weeks left at North American Martyrs. It has been a joy to get to know some of you and I look forward to continuing to get to know you all as I wrap up this very quick summer! As Jesus said in the Gospel, so I too ask you, please beg the Lord to send out laborers for his harvest. Pray for your priests, pray for seminarians, and please pray for me as I rapidly approach ordination.


