G reetings!,

It is hard to believe that this past weekend already came and went, but what a weekend it was! Thank you to everyone who came to the Harvest Festival on Saturday night; it was an awesome atmosphere! However, I think we all owe a BIG thank you to the organizers and all the volunteers who made it go off without a hitch. So many good things at North



American Martyrs happen due to generous organizers and volunteers, I am so grateful for that.

October 5/6 starts the Bishop's Appeal for Vocations (BAV). We do have a unique situation in our diocese. If you've ever heard visitors to our churches from outside of the diocese, they look at our posters of Seminarians and exclaim, "Wow! There are so many!" This year we had a huge increase of 17 young men join in one year. This is absolutely amazing!! However, it does greatly increase the needs this year. The cost of their education is very great. Even the seminarians themselves have to provide \$5,000 to enter. This can be a big strain on families, but it's a sacrifice that is just part of the vocation. The cards for donating are in the Narthex. Even if you haven't given before, please help provide for the Church in the Diocese of Lincoln, Nebraska. Every dollar over our parish goal comes right back to us.

Pray for vocations to help the world rediscover Christ. The harvest is plenty ... but the laborers are few (Matthew 9:37).


