A Note from our Pastor...

As October has come to a close, we look forward to November. In this month, it is tradition in the Catholic Church to pray for, commemorate, and remember all who have passed from this world into eternity. Praying for the dead is when the Church Militant (a term used for those of us who are here in



this life) encourages and supports the Church Suffering (the term used for the souls in purgatory, going through the preparation process to enter into Heaven).

Many other Christians do not understand the teaching of purgatory. Here is a simple guide:

- 1. Praying for the souls of the departed is Scriptural: 2 Mac 12:44-46 (atonement for dead to free them from sin). 1 Cor 3:15 (suffer loss, but saved as through fire), 1 Pet. 3:18-20; 4:6 (Jesus preached to the poor souls in prison), 2 Tim 1:16-18 (Paul prays for dead friend Onesiphorus).
- 2. Purgatory makes sense.
 - a. If Heaven is perfect, then nothing imperfect can enter.
 - b. We are who we are at the time of our deaths, and every human (other than Mary) is imperfect at the time of death.
 - **c.** Therefore, some change *has* to take place between our death and our entrance into heaven. That place/time/space of change is simply purgatory.

We'll have a binder up by the ambo if you want to add the names of your dearly departed and our parish will be praying for them.

Second Note: We had around 100 people come to our RIM formation after the 9:30am Mass. This short presentation by our Evangelization Team is for everyone! It describes simple, easy ways to understand and live our Relationship, Identity, and Mission with Jesus Christ. Food and child care provided! Last week had Casey's breakfast pizza. 


