


A Note from our Pastor...

ANNUAL REPORT OF

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul of North American Martyrs Parish, St. John de Brebeuf Conference would Like to take this opportunity to thank our parishioners for their dedicated support to serving those in need by your donations to our conference. We submit a summary of fiscal year activities from October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024.

Parishioners generously donated \$45,980 in contributions, plus \$872 in special donations. The conference received additional funds from the Lincoln Council fund raising and donating efforts totaling \$5,300. Our expenses for the year totaled \$39,269 in direct service to those in need; \$21,314 helped with rent; \$14,528 with utilities; \$3,427 with food, personal care items, housewares, medical bills, phone bills, and car gas/licensing/maintenance/repair.

Approximately 301 people including family households were assisted. Vincentians accomplished this with 122 home visits. Thank you for your generosity.

Perhaps you are being called to join our work? Our conference has 14 active member (5 new members in the past year) and 3 associative members. We are looking for new members to join our conference in making visits to those in needs. There is training and we visit those who call us in teams of two. Each team makes an average of two calls per month, based on availability. Please contact one of the members or the Parish office if you are interested in learning more.


